We want to transport you to Italy where you can discover not just the famous wines but also the lesser-known varieties and with over two thousand grape varieties in Italy, we are very spoiled for choice.

You will also find some Australian wines as I wanted to showcase our best producers that are making vino from Italian grape varieties. The ones you will find in the list, from my point of view, are wines made truly respecting the origin of the grapes and winemaking techniques, as well as Australia's climate and soils.

This list is focused on organic and biodynamic wines, not because it's trendy, but because I strongly believe that minimal intervention in the vineyard and winery allows the wine to fully express itself and its origins. As much as we look after ourselves and our backyard, viticulturists and winemakers do that in the vineyard and in the winery. After embarking on work experiences in great vineyards over the years, I've learnt to understand why the 'natural' approach is so important when making wine.

Nowadays the wine industry is still very male dominant and while there have always been so many female winemakers making incredible juice in Italy and the globe, I wanted to celebrate these wonderful human beings by making special mention throughout the menu.

Our Italian wine offering is extensive and diverse and there are enough in here to suit all tastes. There isn't a bottle on this list that I wouldn't order myself so I encourage you to try something new – you might be surprised. One of the greatest (personally THE greatest) grape varieties, NEBBIOLO. This elegant, noble, complex and super sexy grape variety is majorly planted in the north-west of Italy, in the Piemonte region. Nebbiolo is extremely expressive, which allows every subregion of this beautiful place to shine and celebrate the different soils and microclimates. Remember: in these wines you will always find great acidity, present tannins, red fruits and tar. And of course.... Romance!

Good introduction to this grape variety, with wines made to be drunk early, even though, you can have great aged Nebbiolo.

Super Tuscans - The Rebels

Why 'Rebels' you might ask! At the end of the 1960s few winemakers in Toscana felt a bit too restricted by the Italian wine law, which dictated quite strictly how to make wine, what grapes to use and in what percentage. Some wineries then decided to produce extremely high quality wines labelling them 'table wine'. They also realised that bordeaux-style varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Syrah and Petit Verdot were a good fit for the sandy coastal area of Toscana (Tenuta San Guido planted their first vines of Cabernet in the 40s). Sangiovese and the other native varieties were still widely used and the freedom of blending them with the French ones allowed them to make very distinctive and diverse wines. One thing in common: they are intense and layered. They can swing from a lighter and more elegant style to a bold, round and structured one. What do they make you think about? Did you say steak?

Home of the nebbiolo grape, destroyed in WW2 & rebuilt not long after. Simply put a love child of cola & root beer with herbal bitterness.

Amaro Ciociaro (Lazio, ITA) 10
Super secret amaro it's named after the region it hails from, the producers only disclose its made from alcohol, sugar & herbs - no shit! It is dark in colour & tastes sweet with bitter orange & chocolate.

Amaro Lucano (Basilicata, ITA) 10
Mahogany colour, medium sweetness & herbal bitterness with cinnamon, licorice & caramel hanging around.

Cappelletti Pasubio (Trento, ITA) 10
Monte Pasubio in the Dolomites is famed for its road with 52 tunnels. Built by the Italian army. A woody nose but expect cola & berries.

Petrus Boonekamp Amro (Bologna, ITA) 12
A legendary Italian amaro, Petrus Boonekamp is claimed to have been invented by the eponymous distiller in 1777. Ingredients include galangal & coriander. Higher in ABV at 45%, a big bitter beast.

Cappelletti Elisir Novasalus Vino Amaro (Trento, ITA) 9 / 75
Low ABV, dark in colour but with crazy layers of bitterness & not much sweetness.

Carciofo (Artichoke) Amari

Cynar (Lombardy, ITA) 9
Low ABV at 16.5% this amaro is made with artichoke, more on the savory/earthy side with a sweet caramel finish.

Amarcardo Amaro Di Carciofino Selvatico Dell'etna (Sicily, ITA) 12
Made from artichokes grown on volcanic slopes in Sicily's oldest distillery. Smells like orange fruit cake, expect semi sweet spiced orange & ginger bread.

Cardamaro (Piemonte, ITA) 11
A moscardo infused with cardoon, ginger & artichoke then aged for 6 months. Tastes like candied spice & nuts.

Alpine Amari

Amaro Braulio (Lombardy, ITA) 10
Born in the Italian Alps, near the Swiss border, it features heaps of secret alpine herbs. Highly aromatic, floral bitterness with pine & spearmint leading the way.

Bepi Tosolini Amaro D'Erbe (Friuli, ITA) 19
The herbs are macerated in brandy & the water from the Friulian Alps. Full bodied, sweet freshness with a typically herbal finish.

Rabarbo Amari

Cappelletti Rabarbaro Sfumato (Trento, ITA) 10 / 85*
Rabarbaro, otherwise known as smoky rhubarb, this is a wine based version of a challenging but fun woody, smoky, tobacco mouthful. *Price per 250ml carafe.

Zucca Rabarbaro Amaro, Lombardy 12
A firm fixture of the Milanese cafe culture & is a whole lot of smoky, woody rhubarb goodness.

Fernet

Fernet Branca (Lombardy, ITA) 12
Arguably Italy's most iconic amaro & originally used as an anti-choleric. Burnt caramel colour, very medicinal, candy cane & toothpaste.

Branca Menta (Lombardy, ITA) 12
Legend has it that it's inspired by opera singer Maria Callas enjoying Fernet Branca with crushed ice & mint to soothe sore throat. It's dark in colour, very herbal with blasts of spearmint & peppermint.

Grappa

Nv Domenis Storica Nera Uve (Friuli, ITA) 14
Classic white acquavite made from a blend of red grapes. Round yet fragrant on the palate with a delicate bouquet.

Nv Occhipinti (Sicilia, ITA) 15
Made from Frappato grapes, this grappa is crystal clear, soft and round. On the nose is floral and spicy.

2007 Castello Di Uviglie 'le Cave' (Piemonte, ITA) 12
Made from Barbera grapes, this grappa has been aged for 7 years in ash wood.

NV Villa De Varda 'barricata Piu' (Trentino, ITA) 14
A blend of aromatic grapes varieties, this grappa is aged for 36 months in small, toasted French barriques.

Nv Azienda Agricola Buganza (Piemonte, ITA) 12
Spending few months in wood, this Nebbiolo based grappa releases notes of apricot, honey and candied fruit.

Nv Questa E' Vera Grappa 'stravecchia' (Veneto, ITA) 16
Aged for 24 months in small french barriques, this true grappa shows toasted notes of vanilla and sweet spices.
