White

Pepper Tree Wines 'Alluvius' Semillon 2018 Hunter Valley, NSW \$78

The name 'Alluvius' derives from the well drained, 'alluvial' soils found in vineyards planted close to river beds. Pure Semillon fruit of lime cordial and lemon sherbert showcase this classic Hunter Semillon. The palate is intense yet elegant displaying mineral texture with great line and length.

Nick Spencer Wines Gruner Veltliner 2018 Tumbarumba, NSW \$65

Sourced from a vineyard that lies at 700 meters above sea level in Tumbarumba it has aromas of grapefruit, pear, Granny Smith apples. The wine is bright, crunchy, and refreshing with lovely texture and length.

Tyrrell's 'Vat 63' Chardonnay Semillon 2017 Hunter Valley, NSW \$92

The 80% Chardonnay was sourced from the HVD Vineyard and the 20% Semillon was sourced from Vat 1. The palate has the combination of the strength of chardonnay fruit and the finesse and freshness of Semillon.

Domaine Naturaliste 'Purus' Chardonnay 2014 Margaret River, WA \$83

Made by local WA legend Bruce Dukes this wine has a richly fruited palate and reveals a balance of expansive fruit, texture and sophisticated elegance. Flavours of nashi pear, stone fruit and dried figs mingle with notes of hazelnut and creamy vanilla bean.

Red

Domaine Paul Pillot 'Bourgogne' 2015 Burgundy, France \$105

This is an absolutely fabulous Pinot Noir from a great vintage. The pretty, lifted nose offers red cherry and rose like aromatics and the palate is ripe and energetic with lip smacking freshness.

Silkman 'Reserve' Shiraz 2014 Hunter Valley, NSW \$88

This wine has amazing aromas of cherries and mulberries are layered over delicate notes of dried spice and toasty oak. Impeccable premium Shiraz from a landmark vintage.

Speri 'La Roverina' Valpolicella 2015 Veneto, Italy \$63

The Speri family's presence in the heart of Valpolicella goes back to 1874. Ruby red, with an intense, ample nose recalling grapey and almond notes; dry, flavourful and structured

Tamburlaine 'Reserve' Malbec 2017 Orange, NSW \$75

This Multi award winning Malbec (runner up at the Jimmy Watson) has Violets, mulberry and dark cherry aromas with a palate of rich fruit driven with light spice, vanilla and anise.

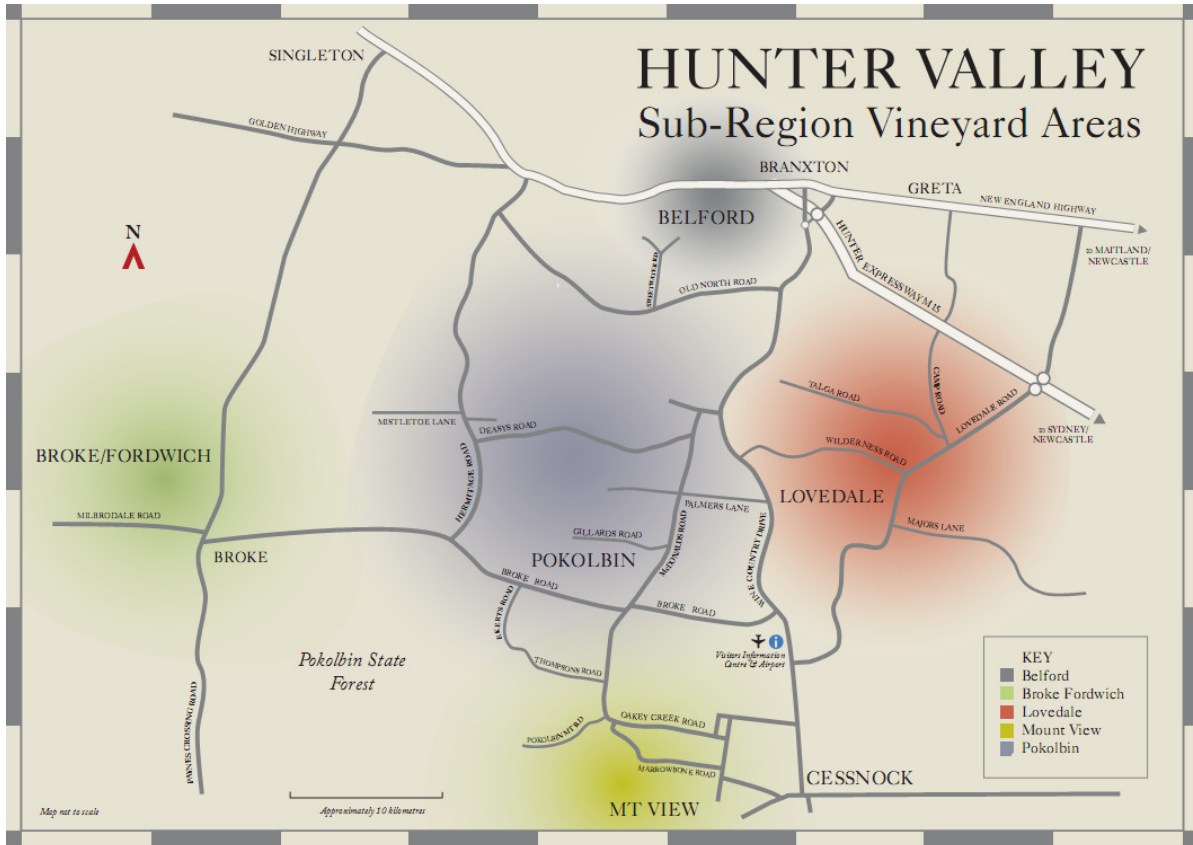

Semillon

As self appointed international Hunter Valley Semillon ambassadors, we feel it's about time to celebrate and share one of the greatest expressions of this variety made anywhere in the world.

The Hunter has a rare affinity with Semillon. Some say it's the Hunter's abundance of old river beds that run through some of the regions and Australia's best and oldest vineyards. Some say it is the unique climate of hot weather, coastal influence and sometimes (more often than not) late season rainfall that suit the early ripening Semillon grape.

Whichever way you look at it Semillon is an amazing variety. In its youth it is vibrant, full of fresh citrus and refreshing acidity. As a cellaring wine it is one of the greatest in the world and can live for 20 or more years transforming into a rich, soft and full wine that has amazing complexity and texture.

When young it's great with fresh seafood. Think oysters, prawns and white-fleshed fish; at 10 or so years it goes with smoked trout, scallops, roast chicken and lobster.

A bottle of good Hunter Semillon, some seafood and close friends is one of life's great pleasures.



Pokolbin

Home of some of the most well known producers and oldest vineyards this region strives for elegance, complexity and purity of flavour. Pokolbin has a unique combination of sandy soils, rich in nutrients and a unique local microclimate that provide these wines with incredible aging potential.

The Braemore Vineyard

A vineyard, located within a strip of fine white sand on Hermitage Road, Pokolbin, Braemore is considered to be one of the Hunter Valley's best sites for Semillon. Since the early 1970s it has been the source material for some of the Hunter's finest and most age-worthy white wines.

"The name 'Braemore' has only been around for 26 years, but, as a vineyard, it has this historical reputation that makes it feel as though it has been here forever," - winemaker Andrew Thomas

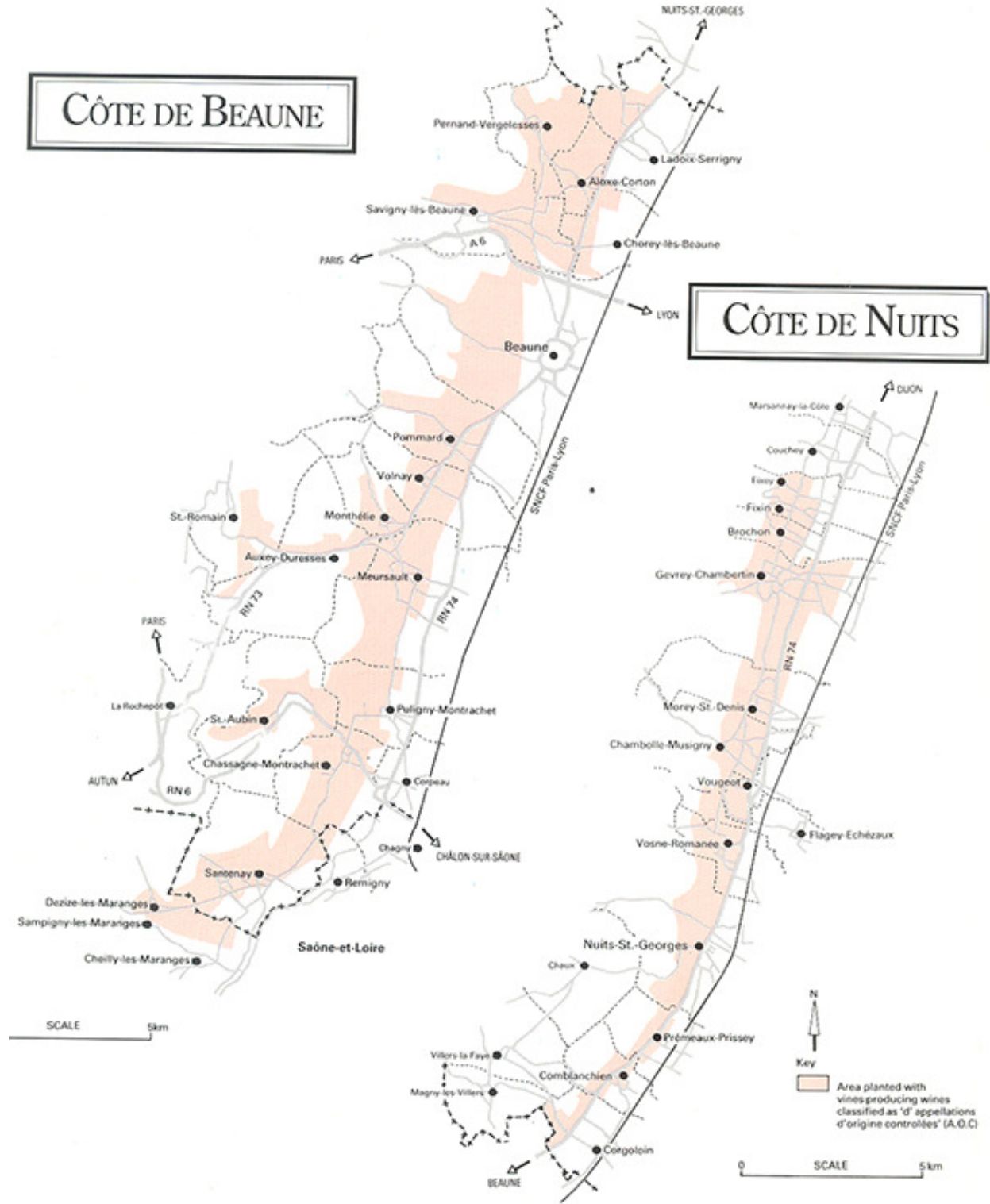
